



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## TRIED & TESTED APPROACH




The project team leader is ultimately responsible for the success of any project. This position is often filled by the Project Manager however in some instances an additional Barrett Group team member may be allocated in order to have an autonomous management role. The team leader reports directly to our senior client representative and is available at all times if needed. Our team leader is fully aware of their responsibility and accountability and happily accepts this role.

#### **Project Manager**

Our project managers assume the total operational control of all projects at a day to day level. They control the projects once Barrett Group is awarded the contract from our clients.

They are responsible for preparing and letting sub contracts to our preferred contractors, establishing and maintaining a project schedule, monitoring project costs from both and internal and external perspective, managing and chairing site meetings when required and finally ensuring defects are minimised and when evident at handover are rectified in a timely manner.

In all of their projects both large and small they always have an overlap of skilled staff to ensure that our projects run smoothly on time and on budget. On every project the following specific roles will be allocated from our experienced team members.



#### **Set Out Manager**

An integral part to the success of any project is the skills that our set out staff bring to their projects. The "reference" of set out is quite limiting, as the skills our team bring to projects is far beyond what it used to be. All of our projects are now set out with an auto cad derivative called Pytha.

Pytha is the industry leading computer aided design tool and it is a magnificent aid to any project. Not only does it set out each individual joinery piece, our staff use it more widely to set out an entire venue which ensures 100% accuracy.


Our set out staff are all very technically minded and ensure that our in-house quality control measures are adhered to. This division of Barrett Group ensures compliance to design specification, Australian Standards, and will report to the project manager to confirm that materials and joinery is delivered to site when required.

#### **Site Foreperson**

All Barrett Group projects are assigned a site foreperson. This role is critical to ensure the efforts of the project manager and set out manager are strictly adhered to onsite, thus resulting in the overall project delivery. Our site foremen are very hands on in the running of the job as well as assisting his site team with the installation of the joineries we supply. The majority of our site foremen have all progressed through our company from apprentices to site hands and finally the highly regarded role as foreman. As the site foreman assumes the role of site manager it is essential that he has excellent communication skills and rapport with many external stakeholders particularly our client.

It is with this formal approach to running our projects that we have consistently seen success. We have found that with this structure in place our projects run more smoothly than our competitors and we have a much tighter control of the project costs. It is this system that we see as our core offering to our clients and best method to add value to their fit-out experience.
